Parent Partnership

We believe a supportive partnership between home and school is an essential ingredient for a child's successful education. Therefore, we have been following the Leading Parent Partnership Award (LPPA) framework which is a nationally recognised award aimed at developing effective communication between the academy and home. The framework encourages parents to be involved in their children's learning leading to improved outcomes in all aspects of school life.

Covid Vaccinations

The COVID-19 vaccinations for children aged 12 to 15 years of age were administered by the Leeds School Immunisation Service today to all those who had given consent to receive their first dose. The purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection to the children who receive the vaccine, to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population and to reduce disruption to education. Feedback from the nursing team was very positive and they commended our students for their calm, mature behaviour.
